Financial update and statements (Matt De Souza):

Nailed the winter budget- surplus ~\$200

Still large surplus from summer, usually around \$10K. Currently ~\$15K. Rained out games + a few more registrations + good equipment management.

- Use this \$ to update some uniforms
- Possibly look into shade tents or other ways to use the surplus. Want to reinvest in league
- Registration fees look like ~\$250 for Thursday nights. \$225 for Saturdays.

Discipline (Gaston): Card count

Good record this winter- 13 cards in total. All cards in ~5 weeks. 4 teams with 0 cards. No issues to report.

Mission 64S

Saturday league has been around for a long time. Currently at 4-6 teams. We really want to get this back to a consistent 6 teams. How can we do this?

As a token of appreciation for bringing a new player in summer, you get priority registration in winter.

We're having an issue with fields, culture, etc.

Adam U- thinks we are potentially rewarding players who bring in players, and this does not seem fair.

Ray- how is this proposal less complicated than the request for previous managers.

Denis- this is a 1 time thing

Bill- the issue with Saturday is simply about timing. Maybe switch to a different time/day. Maybe poll the membership to see what are the barriers to playing on Saturdays.

Denis- we will likely see the same barriers we know about- some like to cottage, some have kids who keep them busy. Previously these changes have ever gained traction.

Bill- demographic has changed, maybe

Jeff- volunteers get priority registration. Incentivize people to bring new players – pay them retroactively for bringing a new player/maybe get a discount on registration if we bring in a new player

Jose- maybe add a requirement that new players have to play a set number of games to be considered.

Glen- if we have an asshole clause, why don't we have a more open registration process. Ray- prevention, avoid issues before they happen.

Ray- how many guys who played on Saturdays with 5 teams, were happy? Is it a necessity to have 6 teams?

Denis- worried we may lose more field time moving forward

Denis – how many people don't want to move forward with the suggested retroactive priority registration- 18

Vote on referral bonus of some kind if you bring a guy for summer- 18 How many for- 13

Absenteeism- Gaston

Most importantly- this is not a big problem, but it does come into play when it comes to draft night and how to pick the right guys.

Everyone knows that Team Snap is the best way to keep everyone on track with attendance One issue- some players who are already injured are drafted and miss several weeks at the beginning of the season.

We hav eto be honest about how long we will be absent so we can accommodate with long term spares.

Idea- during registaration, we could have an attestation where we say that we will use TeamSnap to the best of our ability, and that we will do our best to be there for our team. But what happens is you don't show up. After X amount of games, manager would have a convo to see if something is up.

If a problem persists, Exec would have a conversation with the offending member.

If the problem persists to a 3rd level, your attestation would allow us to move you to the spares list, at Exec discretion.

Paul- doesn't this already exist? What is the proposal?

Matt- there is already verbiage to include this, we just want to make this clear to members so there is no surprise if things happen.

Denis- this comes from rebalancing questions, when some teams have big-time absenteeism and they can't rely on some players not being there.

Alex- nothing more frustrating than trying to confirm with players who never mark their status.

With the goal of player safety, and considering the other two turf leagues don't allow it, instead of only "strongly discouraging" slide tackling in the Saturday 11s league, that slide tackling be banned (automatic direct free kick in the event someone deliberately leaves their feet), and automatic yellow at a minimum if there's contact with another player. Given the league has different levels of players, not everyone has the ability, and not everyone is able to guarantee a clean tackle all the time this will limit the risk of injury. Exception to this rule would be Keeper inside 18yd box; or a situation where player is sliding to keep the ball from crossing the side or goal lines without an opposing player anywhere near (5 or less yards of) said slide (to the referees discretion)
